Did you ever want to learn to quilt? Or, do you want to improve your quilting skills? Don't want to buy expensive equipment?

Come join the newly reinvented Sunscape Cut-Up Quilters (SCU Quilters)! Historically, Sunscape has had two quilting groups with a total of 50 participants. One group emphasized developing skills and the other focused on providing quilts to the needy. On November 20, quilters met and decided to become one group providing both aspects of the previous two groups to build a stronger community and to minimize duplication of supply needs. Tuesdays and Wednesdays, we will offer training for the person who wants to learn to quilt for the first time, as well as refining and growing new skills for the experienced quilter. We will encourage quilters to bring their own projects (at their own expense) to work on during our group sessions and mentoring each other. On Thursdays, we will encourage all quilters to assist in the creation of quilts for charities providing residential care for drug rehabilitation, disabled veterans, and others. (The quilters give away over 191 quilts a season.)

Quilters must supply themselves with a rotary cutter, thread, fabric and batting for personal projects. The group has sewing machines, cutting pads, and rulers, etc. that are for the use of all. The group also supplies all the items needed for making quilts for charity.

Even if you have never sewn a stitch, you can participate! Come check us out!

We are now accepting credit cards for purchases over \$10.00. Any charge over \$400.00 will be charged a 2% service fee.
