Subject: Candidate Campaign Practices

Background:

As the process of the Board of Director Elections has evolved, it has become apparent that direction needs to be given regarding acceptable practices in the use of Park common areas and communication venues in the promotion of BOD Candidates. This policy will offer a guideline for Candidates throughout the election campaign process.

Policy Guidelines:

This policy is issued to clarify the accepted practices during the Election Campaign Process:

1. Park Common Areas and Buildings:
 - BOD Candidate campaign signage is **not** allowed
2. Park Communication Venues:
 - BOD Candidate promotion is **not** allowed via the Park Website, Facebook Page, Newsletters, Email Lists or other Park communications.
3. Park Mail Service:
 - BOD Candidate promotion is **not** allowed via the Park Mail Service. Promotion allowed through standard use of the U. S. Postal service only.
4. Candidate Application/Resume:
 - Park approved application to be used. Two 8 ½" x 11" sheets, front only.
 - Personal endorsements **not** allowed.
 - Return completed Application/Resume to Election Committee Chairperson.
5. Campaigning time:
 - BOD candidates may solicit door to door only between Sunrise and Sunset.
6. Candidates and their representatives' identification:
 - When soliciting, candidates and those representing them, must wear Sunscape identification name tags.
7. Campaign signage:
 - Must include both first and last name of Candidate.
 - Must support the candidate.
 - Must not create a hazard to public safety.
 - Must not be more than 10 square feet.
 - Must have the permission of the member if placed on a non-park lot.
8. Signage time frames:
 - Signs may be displayed up to 60 days before the Annual Meeting date.
 - Candidates are responsible to see that their signs are removed on or before 5 days after the Annual Meeting.
